## Registration Information

All students who will be 5 years old by August 31, 2019 are invited to register for Kindergarten.

Online **Registration begins January 12, 2019 and you must register by March 21, 2019 to be eligible for the first round of assignments.** Please visit [www.somerville.k12.ma.us/Kindergarten](http://www.somerville.k12.ma.us/Kindergarten) to begin. Have the following documentation and information available to facilitate the registration process:
