ECIP Peer Information

What is ECIP?

The Early Childhood Intervention Program (ECIP) is a Somerville Public Schools preschool program that serves children 3-5 years old both with and without Individualized Education Plan (IEP). There are four integrated classes that consist of up to 15 students, less than half have an identified disability.

Who is a Community Peer?

Students without an Individualized Education Plan (IEP) serve as peers for children with disabilities in the ECIP program. Children who possess strong play and social communication skills and are able to speak clearly are successful peers. If your child has an (IEP) he/she is not eligible to be entered into the ECIP lottery.

To have your child considered as a peer in the ECIP program you must be a Somerville resident, your child must turn 3 by February 28th and **not** eligible for the Smile Preschool Program. Children who are 4 years old by August 31st may register for the Somerville Public Schools SMILE Preschool Program. Children should be fully toilet trained. If you are interested in having your child participate in the lottery as a peer you can attend an informational meeting (times and location listed below) or obtain a Lottery Form from the Parent Information Center or online at the Somerville Public Schools website.

Two meetings will be held at the **Capuano Early Childhood Center** to explain the ECIP program and to give details about the lottery:

Thursday, January 31, 2019 at 9:00 am

Lottery Forms will be distributed at this time. Forms can be picked up at the Parent Information Center during school hours 7:30 am – 3:30 pm and they will also be available on the Somerville Public Schools website (www.k12.somerville.ma.us). All lottery forms must be completed and returned in person to Nancy Holmes at the Parent Information Center by 12:00 pm Thursday, February 28, 2019. We will hold a lottery on March 6, 2019 at 9:00 am at the Parent Information Center. Parents will be notified by email/mail if their child is selected as a peer and to schedule a developmental screening.
