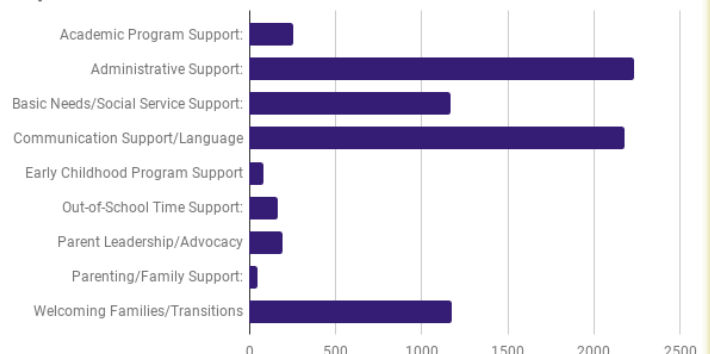
What work is done at the SFLC Enrollment and Registration Office with students and families?
